- You have continuously resided in the United States since the date you submitted your most recent DACA request that was granted;
- · Your previous DACA grant has not yet expired; and
- You have not been convicted of a felony, one significant misdemeanor, or three
  or more misdemeanors, and do not otherwise pose a threat to national security
  or public safety.

If you were convicted of a crime not listed above, arrested or detained by any law enforcement officer and charges were filed, or if charges were filed against you without an arrest, we may still grant your request for DACA. We will evaluate the totality of the circumstances in reaching a decision on whether to grant you deferred action. However, if we determine that you have been convicted of a felony, a significant misdemeanor, or three or more misdemeanors not occurring on the same date and not arising out of the same act, omission, or scheme of misconduct, or that you otherwise pose a threat to national security or public safety, we are unlikely to defer action in your case, except where DHS determines that exceptional circumstances exist.

Caution: USCIS may reject your submission and return it to you with instructions to resubmit your request closer to the expiration date, if you file this request more than 150 days prior to the expiration of your current period of deferred action. USCIS encourages Renewal requestors to file as early in the 150-day period as possible - ideally, at least 120 days prior to your DACA expiration date.
