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# Application For Replacement Naturalization/Citizenship Document



The Application for Replacement Naturalization/Citizenship Document (N-565) is used to apply to U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) for a replacement of a Certificate of Naturalization, Certificate of Citizenship, Declaration of Intention, Repatriation Certificate, or to apply for a special certificate of naturalization to be recognized as a U.S. citizen by a foreign country.

Your eligibility to apply for a replacement document depends on the reason for your request. You may apply for a replacement if:


The A-Number may be located on the front or back of the card, depending on when the card was issued.


# N-565: Your Request - New document - page 3a (conditional)









Evidence to support

As part of the application process, you will need to provide evidence to support your application. These documents help us evaluate your application and verify your answers are true.

You are required to provide several documents now as part of submitting your application. You will also need to provide additional evidence, depending on how you answered certain questions in the application.

### 2x2 photo of you

Upload a recent color photograph of yourself that measures 2 inches by 2 inches, with your face measuring 1 inch to 1 3/8 inch from your chin to the top of your head. Your eyes should be between 1 1/8 inch and 1 3/8 inch from the bottom of the photo.

Make sure your whole face is visible, you are facing the camera

### Medical evidence of legally changed gender

Upload a copy of the medical certification that documents your legally recognized gender change. A medical certification must come from a licensed doctor and include the following:

- Doctor's full name, address, and phone number
- Doctor's medical license number and issuing state
- Doctor's Drug Enforcement Administration registration number or similar foreign number (if any)
- Language stating that you have received the appropriate treatment to change your gender
- Language stating that you have a doctor-patient relationship with the doctor and that he or she has treated you for your gender change


