- 3. This website is best supported by Internet Explorer 11 or higher and Google Chrome 58 or higher.

Note: The time to download each page may vary depending on the speed of your Internet connection. Please be patient.

Instructions for completing the online A/G/NATO Visa Application:

- Enter the information requested into the appropriate spaces on each page. Please answer all
 questions. Your answers must be in English and must use English characters. Letters like ñ, é, ü, ç
 are not recognized by the system. Please enter names like Muñoz and Sémonin as Munoz and Semonin.

 2. Review the information you entered for accuracy.
- 3. Print the confirmation page.

Notice 22 C.F.R.6 41.103 requires an applicant to sign and submit his or her own nonimmigrant visa application unless otherwise exempt. Although the applicant may receive assistance from a third party in preparing the application, the applicant is required to click the "Sign and Submit" button at the end of the application. The applicant's failure to sign the application may result in a termination of the application.

Most visa applicants will need to schedule a visa interview, though some applicants may qualify for visa renewal. The embassy or consulate information may include specific local instructions about scheduling interviews, submitting your visa application, and other frequently asked questions.
