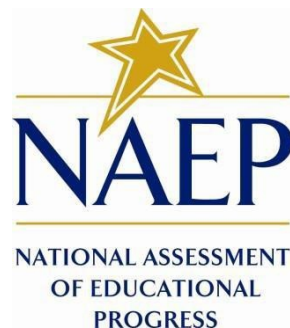

Additionally, grade 8 Science and grade 12 Core, Math, and Reading were previously approved in 2019 (OMB# 1850-0928 v.15), and any changes to the items from the 2019 administration are reflected in summary tables.

Updates to the student survey questionnaires, including new COVID-19 SQs, will be available in this document in Amendment #2 by May 2023. Draft NIES questionnaires will be included in Amendment #2 and final questionnaires will be in Amendment #3 (July 2023).
