 - **o** To facilitate the Bureau's calculations for the Annual 988 Fee Accountability Report, please avoid stray characters such as: *, ~, (), or [] in numeric responses.
- Unless otherwise directed, please provide the requested information directly in response to this form, rather than submitting, referring to, and/or relying on supplemental materials.
- If the reporting entity submitting the questionnaire is including responsive information from subdivisions, e.g., counties, municipalities, or other local jurisdictions, please consolidate any separate response forms (and/or responses to individual questions) completed by those subdivisions into a single response form for the entire reporting entity.

Section 4(b) of the National Suicide Hotline Designation Act of 2020 states:

"FEE ACCOUNTABILITY REPORT.—To ensure efficiency, transparency, and accountability in the collection and expenditure of a fee or charge for the support or implementation of 9–8–8 services, not later than 2 years after the date of the enactment of this Act, and annually thereafter, the Commission shall submit to the Committees on Commerce, Science, and Transportation and Appropriations of the Senate and the Committees on Energy and Commerce and Appropriations of the House of Representatives a report that—

- (1) details the status in each State, political subdivision of a State, Indian Tribe, or village or regional corporation serving a region established pursuant to the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act (43 U.S.C. 1601 et seq.) of the collection and distribution of such fees or charges; and
- (2) includes findings on the amount of revenues obligated or expended by each State, political subdivision of a State, Indian Tribe, or village or regional corporation serving a region established pursuant to the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act (43 U.S.C. 1601 et seq.) for any purpose other than the purpose for which any such fees or charges are specified."
