

National HIV Behavioral Surveillance: Brief HIV Bio-behavioral Assessment (NHBS-BHBA)

Justification for Change

May 24, 2023

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) requests OMB approval for non-substantive changes to a currently approved information collection. Interview data collection instruments, project activities, and annual burden will remain the same as in the previously approved information collection request.
