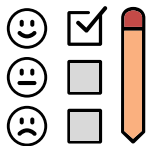

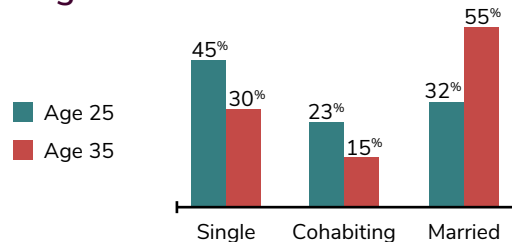
Findings about NLSY 97 women in the labor force



Job satisfaction

Women who reported that they liked their job very much or fairly well increased from 69 percent to 81 percent over a 10-year period.¹

Marital status for women at ages 25 and 35.²



Women's healthcare coverage increased from 74 percent to 86 percent over a 10-year period.³

Researchers value your contributions!

Percent of weeks women were employed, unemployed, or not in the labor force from ages 18 through 34.⁴



Women's health-related work limitations increased from 7 percent at age 25 to 11 percent at age 35.⁵
