

**Revisions to CMS-10708 Instrument – Repetitive, Scheduled Non-Emergent Ambulance Transport (RSNAT) Prior Authorization Model Process and Requirements**

The overall prior authorization process and requirements remain unchanged. The following minor revisions were made to the instrument:
