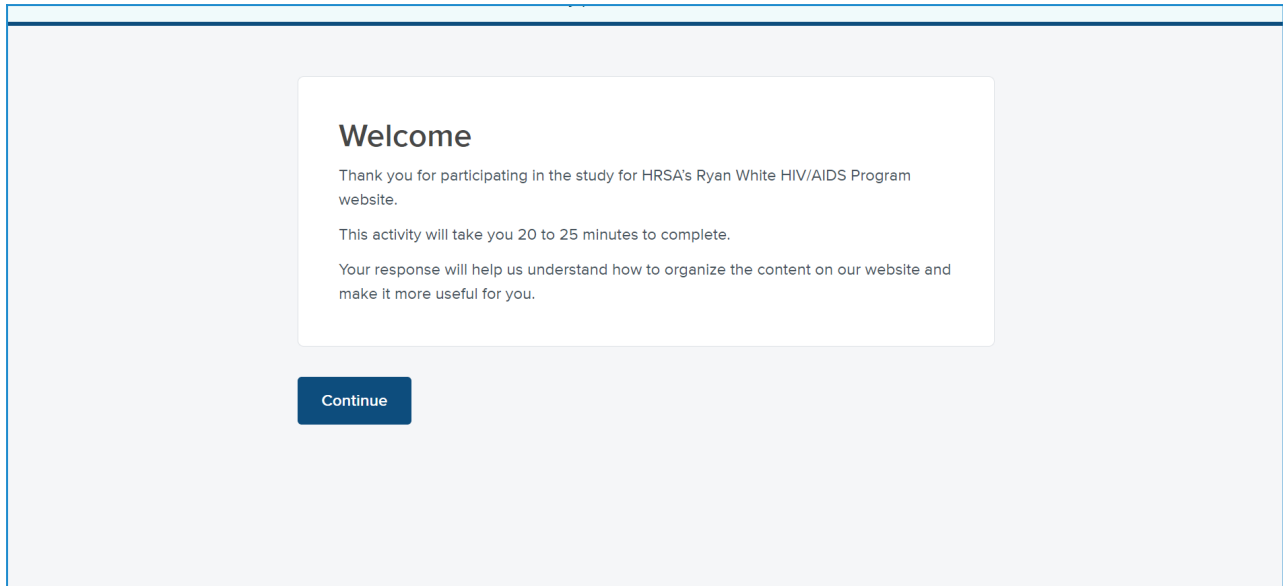

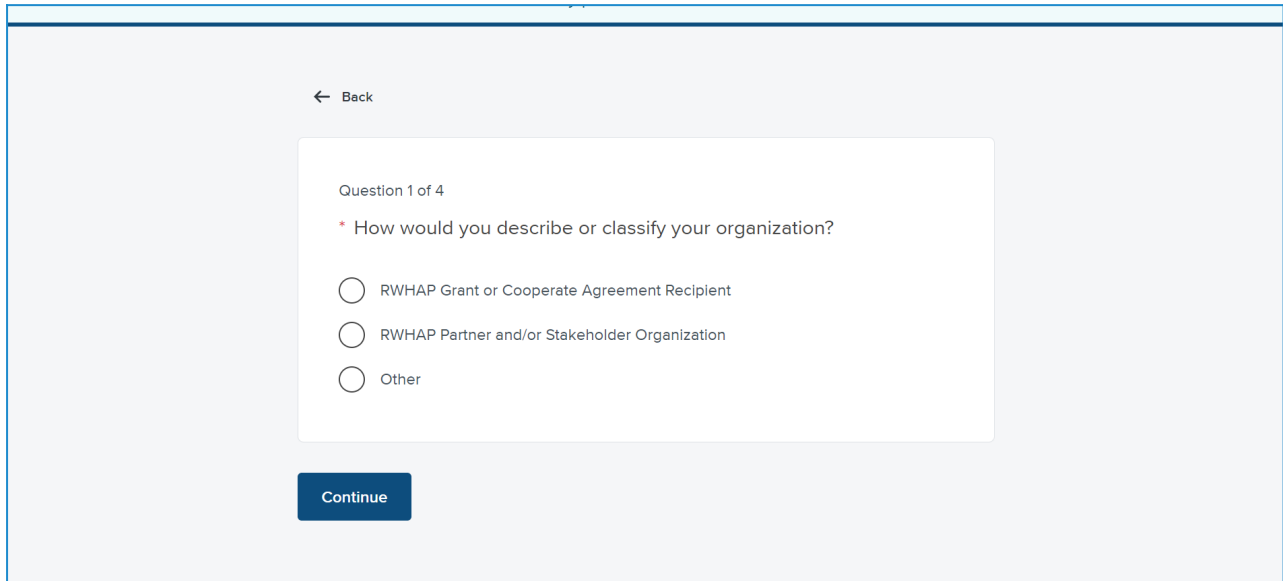



Image 34: Task 14 post-task question




