



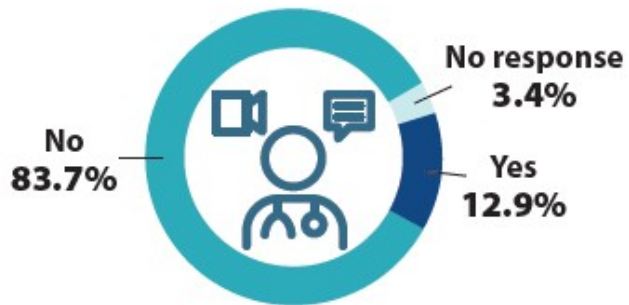
Your Participation Matters: Complete the 2021 National Electronic Health Records Survey

Promoting the electronic exchange of patient health information and understanding prescribing patterns of controlled substances are important for public health. Participating in the National Electronic Health Records Survey (NEHRs) helps measure progress toward achieving goals for improved health care.

NEHRs is an easy way to confidentially share important information about your practice, like telemedicine usage, and measure physician burden. Your participation also highlights the impact and possible barriers that prohibit the exchange of patient health information. Highlighting these data can lead to policy changes and improvement.

Participating in NEHRs is easy: The survey only takes about 20 minutes, and any staff member with knowledge about your practice can complete it. In this short time, your practice can help improve patient care.
