Distance Exercise Starts Here

Please move to the point that best represents the recommended distance.  3) Please move to the point that best represents the minimum distance a person stay away from bison  4) "Don't steal someone else's 'Wow moment!' Please move to the point that best represents the distance from bison a person should stay to avoid stealing someone's Wow moment.  Next, the respondent will walk a 50 yard transect towards a bison cutout. Once they stop at their chosen proximity, the researcher will use a range finder to record the selected distance.  Finally, after the exercise is complete, the technician will resume the survey.
