**AUTHORITY:** Collection of the information solicited on this form is authorized by the following:

- 19 U.S.C. §§66, 1431, 1448, 1481, 1484, 1505, 1514, 1624, and 2071; Title 19, Code of Federal Regulations, including 19 C.F.R. §§24.5, 149.3, 101.9, and 103.31(e); Executive Orders 9397 and 13659.

ROUTINE USES: If you choose to provide the information solicited on this form, CBP will use the information to provide you with an ACE Portal user account. The personally identifiable information (PII) that you provide will not be shared with other government agencies unless they are a Participating Government Agency (PGA), pursuant to an International Trade Data System (ITDS) Memorandum of Understanding, consistent with the receiving agency's legal authority to collect information pertaining to and/or regulate transactions in international trade. ### TOPIC 1: CREATE A MODERNIZED ACE PORTAL ACCOUNT AND LOG IN

#### INTRODUCTION

Before you can access the Modernized ACE Portal, you must create a Modernized ACE Portal account. You can link your Legacy ACE account to your new Modernized ACE Portal account to synchronize your roles. This is a one-time step for the first login.

You can view all your Legacy ACE accounts in the Modernized ACE Portal and toggle between the two applications without logging in again.



**IMPORTANT:** Your ACE Accounts must be active and in good standing to link from the Legacy ACE Portal to the Modernized ACE Portal. Additionally, we recommend using Google Chrome or Edge to access the ACE Modernized Portal.

All fields are required.

#### ONE TIME ACCOUNT CREATION FOR A MODERNIZED ACE PORTAL ACCOUNT

- 1. In an Internet browser (Chrome or Edge), type https://ace.cbp.gov.
- 2. In the **Welcome to the ACE Secure Data Portal** page, select the **Trade/PGA User Login** button.



3. In the login screen, select the **CREATE AN ACCOUNT** button.

#### 4. In the Create Your CBP Account pane:

- a. In the First Name field, type your first name.
- b. In the Last Name field, type your last name.
- c. In the Email field, type your work email address.
- d. In the Create Password field, type a password.



**NOTE:** Passwords must have at least 15 characters at least one lower case letter, one upper case letter, and a number.

Password must contain the following: A lowercase letter A capital (uppercase) letter A number Minimum 15 characters



**TIP:** As you create your password, a checkmark displays when each criterion has been met.

- e. In the Confirm Password field, re-type your password.
- f. Select the SIGN UP button.
