- Real Estate;

- Life insurance; or
- Anything else they own that could be converted to cash and used for food and shelter.

We do not count all of the things they own as a resource. To get SSI, their resources that we do count must be worth less than \$2,000.

The next set of questions collects the types of resources the applicant may own and their values. If they have any of those resources, they may find it helpful to have documents or statements that have the value of the resource with them when answering these questions.
