(This will be "1" unless the trip was a multi-day trip).</p> <p>Number of Anglers - The number of people who fished on the trip (excluding captain and crew).</p> <p>Origin of Trip:</p> <p>State - The state to which the fishing trip returned (use two letter abbreviation).</p> <p>County - The county to which the fishing trip returned.</p> <p>Site Name - of the marina, dock, or launch ramp to which the trip returned. (If private dock, just record "PRIVATE")</p> <p>Effort:</p> <p>Trip Start Time - Time of day vessel departed the dock or ramp for the fishing trip.</p> <p>Trip End Time - Time of day vessel arrived back at the dock or ramp.</p> <p>Total Hours Fished - The amount of time spent actively fishing with gear in the water to the nearest half-hour.</p> <p>Fishing Method - The method of fishing on this trip as defined below.
