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OVERVIEW

The Office of Programs to Enhance Neuroscience (OPEN) Workforce Tracker (OWT) is a secure system to collect data for diversity-related awards at the National Institute of Neurological Disorders and Stroke (NINDS). By collecting regularly updated information provided by our grantees, NINDS will be able to monitor and evaluate the impact of our programs on enhancing workforce diversity over time and better inform the future direction of NINDS diversity-related initiatives. Additionally, NINDS will be able to communicate relevant funding and career development opportunities as you progress along your careers. Our long-term goal is to use the OWT to help us strengthen our programs and help grantees enhance their careers.

Data for individuals in the OWT system will be retained for 10 years.
