a. Progress Reports

Each recipient will be required to submit quarterly progress reports and a final progress report. These reports should include narrative updates on planning grant activities as well as information on each recipient's approved work plan as specified in each recipient's approved application in accordance with the Section 9813 State Planning Grants for Qualifying Community-Based Mobile Crisis Intervention Services.
