Examples of Inquiries to the States

Below are examples of some BLS inquiries to the states:

- 1. Request for state opinion on the functionality of the new QCEW Q2A application that replaced email communication between the QCEW program office, the regional office, and the states.
- 2. Request for information from the states documenting their methodology for generating M01 inputs for non-CES areas.
- 3. Request for state information on how frequently they adjust their state published series, the impact on their work in the context of re-estimates, estimation, and benchmarking used to assess potential updates to the CES application ACESweb.
- 4. Request for OEWS states to provide requested changes to their balance-of-state definitions after the release of OMB's updated MSA definitions.
- 5. Request for feedback from OSHS states for the 2022 OSHS virtual conference.
- 6. Request for OEWS states to fill out a stakeholder survey to provide feedback on BLS publication products and the option for them to provide the survey to state specific data users.
