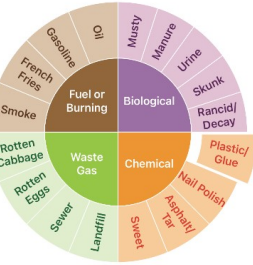

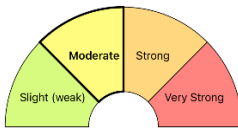

How strong is the smell?



Slight (weak): The smell can be distinguished from other odors.

Moderate: The smell blocks other odors, but isn't bad enough to make you leave.

Strong: The smell is bad enough that you want to avoid it.

Very Strong: The smell produces physical symptoms (for example nausea, difficulty breathing, irritation of the eyes, nose or throat) or a residual smell remains after the odor is gone.

If you are experiencing odors that you feel may be causing life threatening health symptoms, call 911.

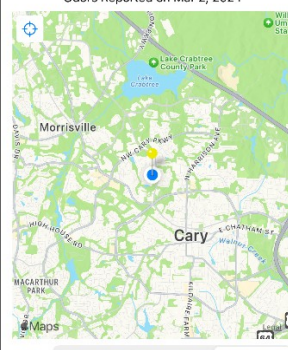

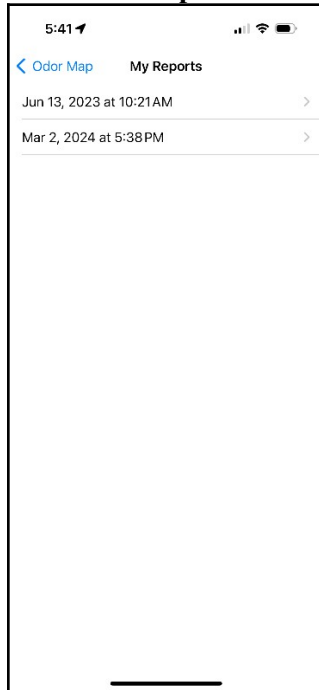

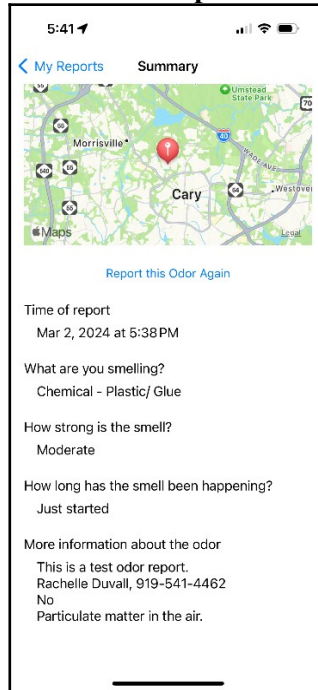
