Dear [FDIC Legal Division Former Employee],

The Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation (FDIC) promotes confidence in the financial system by chartering new banks, supervising and monitoring financial institutions, paying insured depositors quickly, effectively managing failed financial institutions, and providing superior customer services. The FDIC must proactively ensure an ongoing state of readiness to be able to fulfill its statutory mission across different economic cycles.

The FDIC will maintain your response in a secure database which we will use to manage outreach efforts should the FDIC need to add staff in the future. Responding to this letter does not obligate you to accept an invitation to return, and is not a guarantee of future employment. Assignments, if any, will be made based on skill and experience at the discretion of the FDIC.
