Pursuant to 28 C.F.R. 20.37, every criminal justice agency submitting disposition information to the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) is responsible for assuring accuracy, completeness, and currency of the records and must, to the extent possible, ensure that dispositions are made available for all arrest data included on the individual's record. Dispositions should be submitted by criminal justice agencies within 120 days after the disposition has occurred.
- 3. When the arrested person is convicted or pleads guilty to a lesser or different offense than when originally arrested, this information should be clearly indicated.
