

# EEO Mid-Term Report

A radio station employment unit (SEU) with five or more full-time employees is required, on the fourth anniversary of the license renewal application deadline assigned to the stations in the SEU, to indicate if it has 11 or more full-time employees. To calculate the mid-term review deadline, for example, the fourth anniversary for the DC-Maryland-Virginia-West Virginia radio station renewal group falls on June 1, 2023, which is four years after the June 1, 2019 due date for their most recent last license renewal application. License renewal application deadlines for the last license renewal round can be found here: [for radio](#) and [for TV](#). (Note: All license renewal applications are due on the first day of the designated month as specified in 47 CFR 73.1020. If any deadline falls on a weekend or officially recognized federal legal holiday, it is moved to the next business day. 47 CFR 1.4.)

Once an answer is saved, it will display in the Mid-Term Review folder in the EEO Records section. Answers cannot be deleted or amended; licensees wishing to correct an answer on or before their mid-term review deadline should save a new, updated answer. (Note: The FCC defines a full-time employee as a permanent employee whose regular work schedule is 30 hours per week or more and a station employment unit as a station or a group of commonly owned stations in the same market that share at least one employee. 47 CFR 73.2080.)
