If you have an issue or complaint about a school or training facility that's eligible to receive GI Bill benefits, you can submit feedback to VA. You can submit feedback to us if your school isn't following the <u>Principles of Excellence</u> guidelines or if you have any other concerns or issues you'd like to raise with us. Your feedback tells us about practices that may pose risks to students.

VA will review the following types of complaints:

If you are not using VA education benefits please submit your complaint with the appropriate agency:

- Private student loans Consumer Financial Protection Bureau



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


