<b>(ST) – PERFORMANCE MEASURE C.2 (OPTIONAL)</b> # and % of hospitals and EMS agencies submitting data to a statewide integrated data management system	<b>(ST) – PERFORMANCE MEASURE C.5</b> # and % of hospitals and EMS agencies with system -wide workforce development efforts in place to improve clinical knowledge for stroke care and recognition of disparities in stroke care	<b>(ST) – PERFORMANCE MEASURE C.8 (REQUIRED)</b> # of patients at high risk for stroke events or post -acute stroke within clinical and/or community settings that engage with patient navigators or community health workers for follow up and support
<b>(ST) – PERFORMANCE MEASURE C.3</b> # and % of hospitals with an implemented referral tracking system to support transitions of care for stroke patients post-discharge	<b>(ST) – PERFORMANCE MEASURE C.6</b> # and % of EMS agencies and hospitals with established processes (e.g., patient care protocols, feedback loops) for coordination of transitions of care for those at highest risk for stroke events and stroke patients across systems of care	<b>(ST) – PERFORMANCE MEASURE C.9</b> # of individuals within communities and/or clinical settings reached through stroke messaging and education, including populations at high risk for stroke events
<b>(IT) – PERFORMANCE MEASURE (REQUIRED)</b> # and % of entities across stroke systems of care monitoring disparities in identification of stroke risk factors, stroke care, and referrals for populations at highest risk for stroke events compared to all stroke patients	<b>(IT) – PERFORMANCE MEASURE (REQUIRED)</b> # and % of EMS agencies and/or hospitals reporting an improvement in a selected performance measure of care based on identified performance gaps and quality improvement activities	<b>(IT) – PERFORMANCE MEASURE (REQUIRED)</b> # and % of patients linked to community resources and clinical services appropriate to their medical, social and functional determinants of health
