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<b>Who must comply?</b>	Certified Cargo Screening Standard Security Program (CCSSSP) participants.
<b>What is this collection about?</b>	This information collection requires a Certified Cargo Screening Standard Security Program participant to adopt and implement a security program.
<b>Where do I find the requirements for this information?</b>	Title 49 CFR, Part 1549.5(a); 74 Fed. Reg. 47672 (September 16, 2009).
<b>When must information be submitted to the TSA?</b>	Information must be submitted to TSA before a CCSSSP applicant is certified to tender screened cargo for transport on a passenger aircraft prior to receiving certification to conduct validations of CCSSSP applicants.
<b>How is the information submitted?</b>	The information must be submitted in accordance with the regulations. CCSSSP participants may submit information by way of e-mail at <a href="mailto:CCSSSP@dhs.gov">CCSSSP@dhs.gov</a>
<b>What happens when complete information is received?</b>	Once the security program is adopted and implemented, TSA will determine compliance with the program requirements through routine onsite inspections, assessments, and tests.
