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On behalf of our members, the Association of SNAP Nutrition Education Administrators (ASNNA), the non-profit professional organization which represents SNAP-Ed Implementing agencies, reviewed the revised forms, FNS-885 and FNS 886. The attached letter expresses feedback about five key topics and makes recommendations in each: workload, scoring, evidence base, responsiveness, and food security. We would welcome the opportunity to work with USDA in these areas. We also express concern about the delay in posting of the subject documents which shortened the comment period from 30 days to 21, which limited our ability to conduct a thorough review.
