Michigan Fitness Foundation (MFF) as a SNAP-Ed State Implementing Agency reviewed the revised forms, FNS-885 and FNS 886. MFF endorses the comments submitted by the Association of SNAP Nutrition Education Administrators (ASNNA). We echo considerations related to: 1) decreasing the overall page count and questions to reduce workload burden; 2) including scoring criteria that acknowledge flexibility for implementation within unique community contexts; 3) ensuring that interventions and strategies span the social ecological model; 4) recognizing emerging evidence for community and practitioner driven interventions and strategies; and 5) incorporating nutrition security and nutrition assistance as focus behavior. In addition, interventions should be selected because they work, regardless of cost. Consider removing points for cost of a material. Thank you for the opportunity to comment.
