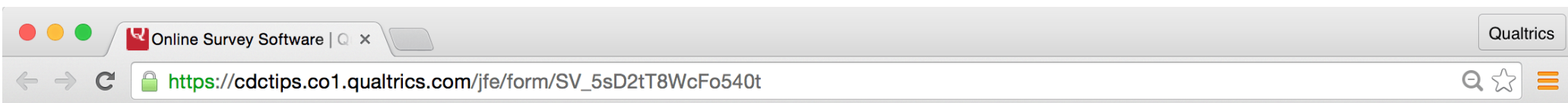

Criteria for continuing on to the main questionnaire:

(1) Adult smokers of regular cigarettes between 18-54 years of age (criteria: persons who reported smoking ≥ 100 regular cigarettes during their lifetime and who, at the time of the survey, reported smoking regular cigarettes every day or some days)

(2) Adult dual user between 18-54 years of age (criteria: current smokers who reported using e-cigarettes, even one time and who, at the time of the survey, reported using e-cigarettes every day or some days)

Approximately 11,200 respondents will continue to the main questionnaire.

Criteria for termination:

(1) non-smokers

(2) persons younger than 18 years of age

Approximately 4800 respondents will be screened out or will abandon and will not continue to the main questionnaire.
