Form 1: Arts Creation and Performance

- 13. **Ask All** Considering all the activities we've asked you about, did you take any **classes or lessons** in any of these art forms during the last 12 months? [Yes/No]

- 6. Ask All Did you go to a crafts fair or a visual arts festival?
- 7. Ask All Did you go out to the movies or go see a film? [Yes/No]
- 8. **Ask All** Did you visit or go see any buildings, neighborhoods, parks or monuments because of their historical, architectural or design value? **[Yes/No]**
- 10. **Ask All** With the exception of books required for work or school, did you read any novels or short stories, poetry, or plays? **[Yes/No]**
