The CATCH Program gives victims of sexual assault an opportunity to anonymously submit suspect information to help the Department of Defense identify serial offenders.

Thank you for considering participation in this program!

Research indicates that some offenders perpetrate sex crimes many times before being reported or caught. This is often because they count on victims never telling law enforcement about what happened. The CATCH Program provides a way for you to anonymously disclose details about your sexual assault to law enforcement and to learn if the suspect has been accused in other reports of sexual assault.

The details you provide about your experience will be compared to reports by others in the CATCH computer system and to other law enforcement databases. If your information appears to match with another report, a SARC, Victim Advocate, or FAP Provider will notify you privately. You can then decide whether to change your reporting preference and to participate in the investigation of the suspected offender.

Your participation in the CATCH Program is voluntary. Your Restricted Sexual Assault Report will not be converted without your permission, and no investigation will be initiated without your voluntary participation. In addition, you may decline to participate in the process at any point, even after being contacted that there was a

If now is not a good time to complete your entry, you can always come back later and enter the information when you feel ready. If you decide to do this some other time, please reach out to your SARC or FAP Provider for a new user name and password for this site. The user name and password you were given expire in 10 calendar days after you received them, or after you use them five times to log on.

There is no requirement for you to participate in the CATCH program. Any information you provide is voluntary.

To save information, you must go to the Review page to review your entry(ies), then select "Submit Report". Your information will not be saved until you select "Submit Report".

- Start The Start button will get you back to this page.
- Incident You do not need to 'save' your inputs before leaving the input page. All inputs will be retained until you Review / Submit.
- . Suspects For each suspect, you must select the 'Save Suspect' option at the bottom of the page after each set of suspect entries is made.
- . Vehicle You do not need to 'save' your inputs before leaving the input page. All inputs will be retained until you Review / Submit.
- Weapons / Threats / Intoxicants / Media You do not need to 'save' your selections before leaving the input page. All selections will be retained until you Review / Submit.
- Review Here you will be able to review all data entries on a single page, with separate tabs for each suspect. Please review all of your inputs prior to selecting the 'Submit Report' option.






FIGURE -6 Vehicle Information


