This field will be prepopulated for all rows of data based on the selection made in the drop-down for 'Select reporting period' from the Start Here tab (See technical guidance for reporting timeline table.) The cells will appear gray to indicate that no additional data entry is needed.

This is a formula field that will generate a total count of health equity focused overdose prevention activities that occurred in a clinical, harm reduction, public safety, or other settings during the designated reporting period once the disaggregates below are entered into the appropriate fields.
