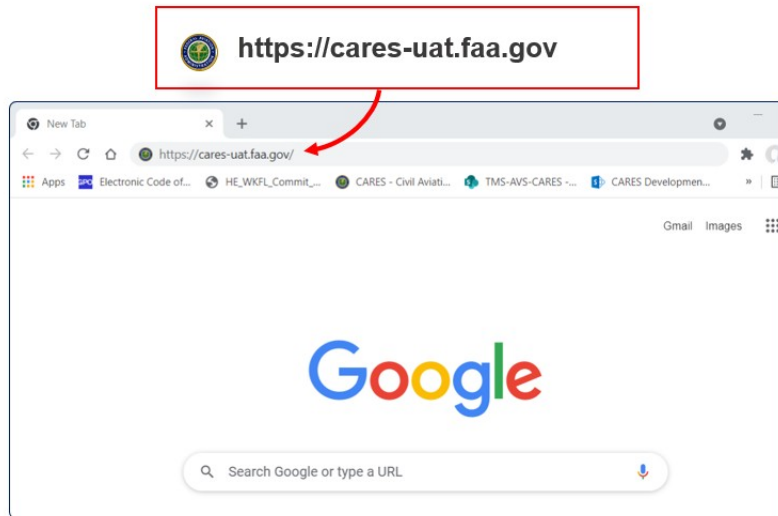


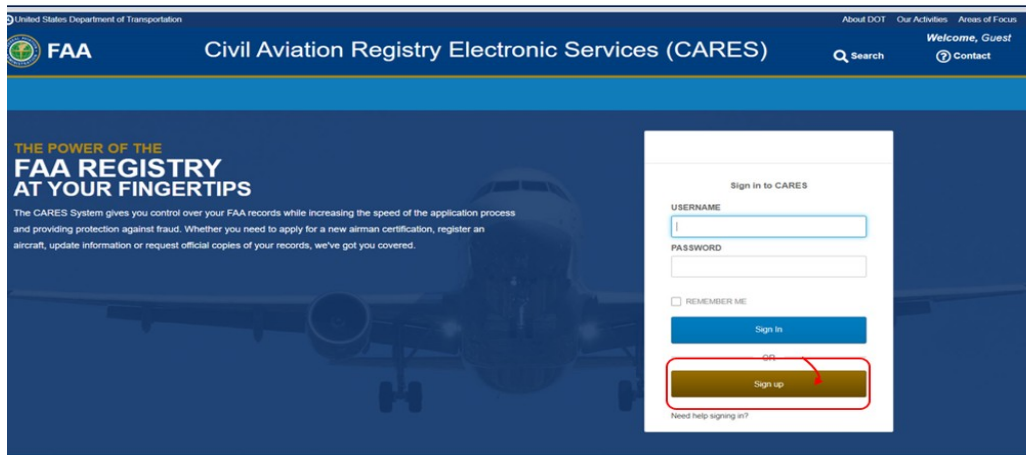
Sign up for a CARES ACCOUNT

Here are the steps to setup a CARES account. In this instance we are using the UAT Environment.

Navigate to the CARES Home page by entering <https://cares-uat.faa.gov>:



The CARES homepage appears. Click the **Sign up** button:



The MyAccess External User Registration page appears. Enter your name and email address in the appropriate fields. Your **First Name**, **Last Name**, and **Email Address** are required. Your email address will be your user name:

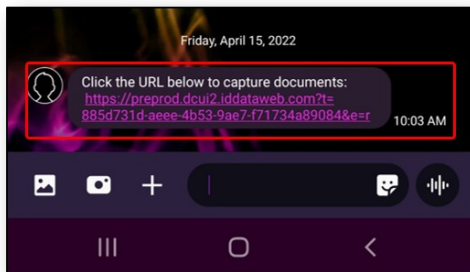

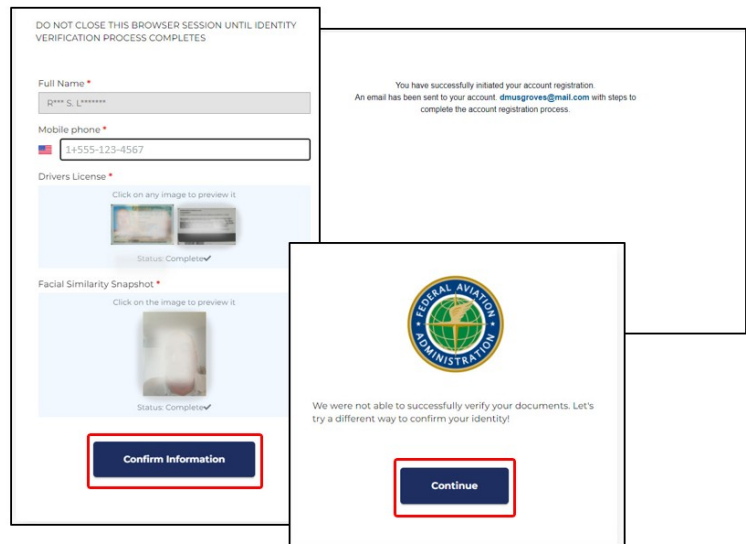

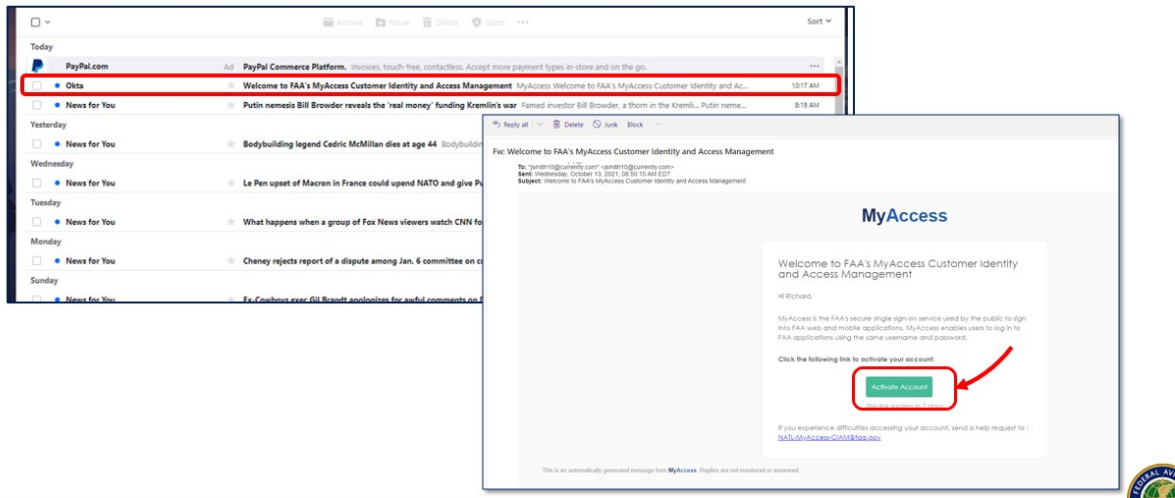

21. Click **Continue**. You will be taken back to confirm your identity by the last four of your SSN:



Activate MyAccess Account

1. In the email that is sent from **FAA's MyAccess**, click the **Activate Account** button to return to CARES and activate your account:



2. The MyAccess welcome page appears. Follow the instructions to create a password and select an image for your account:

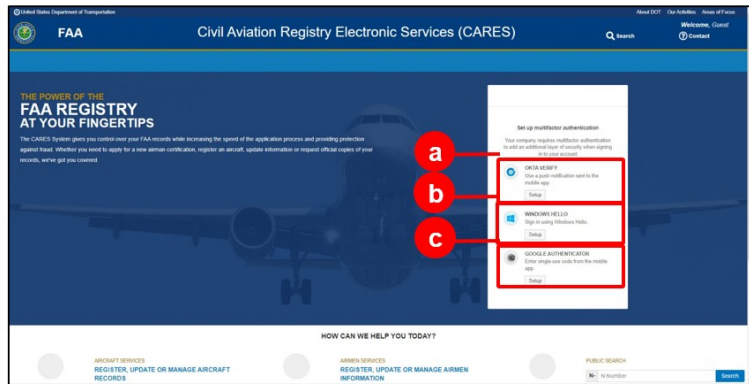

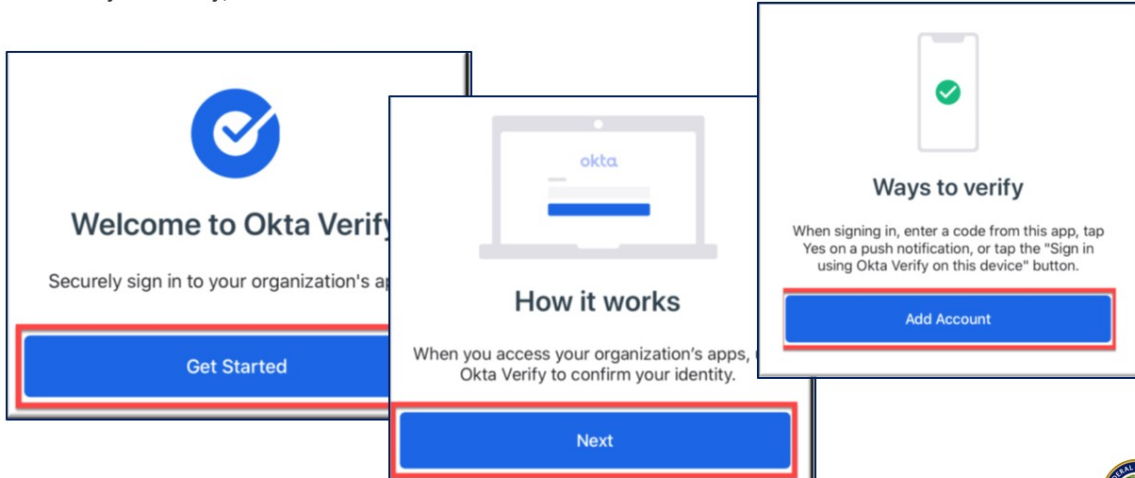

 - c) GOOGLE AUTHENTICATION



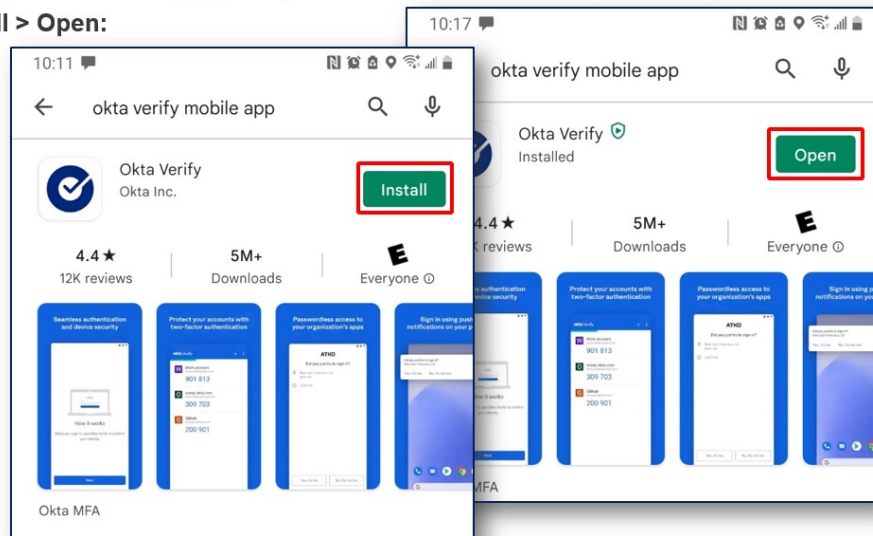
Example of an Okta Verify

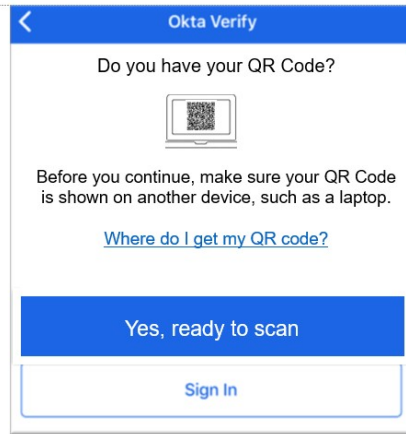
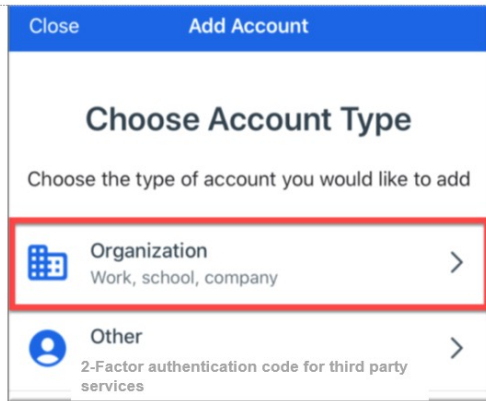
6. To use Okta, download the Okta Verify mobile application in the app store on your phone:

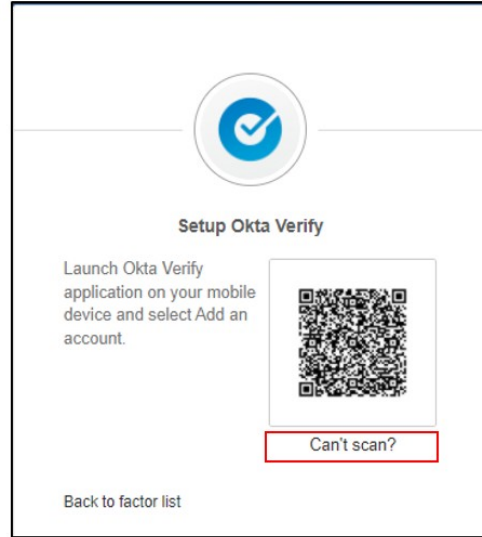
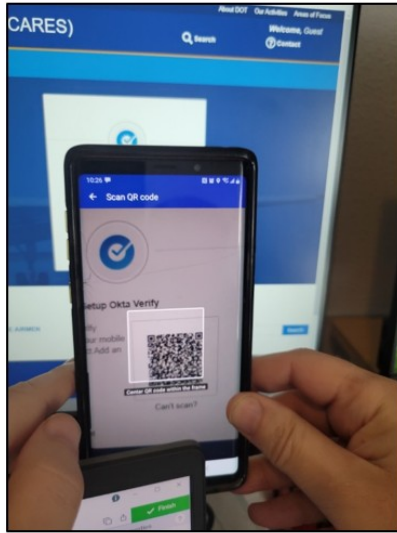
17. In CARES, select the **Setup** button under OKTA VERIFY. The device type popup appears:

18. Select the type of mobile phone you are using. A drop-down appears stating to download the OKTA VERIFY application if you haven't already:

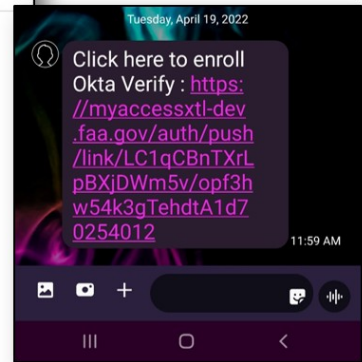
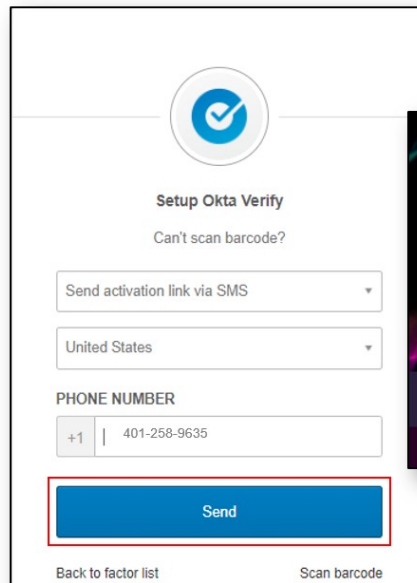
19. Click **Next**. A QR code appears:
