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I think the outline and inclusion of time in units of hours is imperative in the case of natural hazards and disaster; obviously, every grant will have its own rules and no natural disaster is identical, but what remains the same is the need for streamlined communication. There is a critical window of movement for governing bodies to act on needs of at-danger communities, especially those in uncontrollable disaster areas like coastal flooding and rising sea levels. Having a clear and communicable application process for cities to follow will establish trust between local and federal governments, especially in rebuilding communities and strengthening existing bodies like public transportation.

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
