Research - A studious inquiry or examination especially investigation or experimentation aimed at the discovery and interpretation of facts, or revision of accepted facts. Examples include proficiency food safety testing, testing done for new products or variations of existing products, flavor profile, a new formulation or flavor, and re-producing a particular flavor, etc.

Evaluative Testing - In house testing to determine the significance, worth or condition by careful appraisal and study evaluation. To be accomplished through non-laboratory methods such as visual assessment of product and packaging, specifications evaluation, reheating method, machine calibration and performance, comparison to domestic product, and sensory evaluation, etc.

Trade Show Exhibition - Exhibition at an exposition to promote awareness and sales of products within an industry for display and viewing of product at trade show exhibition location. These products are not to be consumed or given away at trade fairs since the imported products haven't had the opportunity to be inspected by FSIS-USDA.

- 16. Method of Disposal: Detailed method of destruction/disposal.
