Dear review team,

As a member of the NECA AETC, most of my comments are included within our group's comments. Here are my separate comments:

1. Our budget was severely cut this 2024/2025 fiscal year. Can we see a budget that includes the printing and training costs of making changes to the names of our typical forms? Can we apply for supplemental funds to cover these costs? Can we see a realistic timeline for how long it will take to train everyone on these changes?
2. I have been involved in many projects that have attempted to follow up on the impact of training on students' careers. Very few students ever fill out the forms they receive long after a training was completed. If we chose a one-year follow-up for IPE, I want to go on record as predicting that we will receive very limited follow up data. Can we be more realistic and measure shorter-term outcomes?
