### **AETC tool review**

The feedback for each tool is organized into the following categories for easier review:

- questions or sections where it would be beneficial to add a definition of certain phrases or terms;
- questions where there is a typo or a need to clarify/reword;
- questions or sections that would benefit from skip logic; and
- questions where we had comments on the content or topic matter being asked of respondents.

### **Crosswalk of new/old tools:**

In addition to reviewing the new AETC tools, we've compiled comments that outline potential data losses and gaps based on the framework and wording of the questions in the new forms. These comments are in the crosswalk excel document attached.
