The aim is to increase the implementation of EBSIs for PHPR activities. Focus areas, objectives, and activities supporting the work plans will be developed based on collective work and decisions of a regional coordinating body of applicable state, tribal, local, and territorial health departments and officials, health care facilities, and health care coalitions, academic, public, and private partners. In addition, two other collection instruments will be used including 1) a Cooperative Agreement Work Plan Template serving as a performance monitoring instrument for project tracking through the performance period and 2) an Evaluation Work Plan Template that provides background information needed to understand approaches in evaluating selected strategies or intervention activities.
