



Medicare

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Medicare is a federal health insurance program for people aged 65 and older. It is run by the Social Security Administration (SSA).

Medicare has two main parts: Part A (Hospital Insurance) and Part B (Medical Insurance). Part A is usually premium-free for most people, while Part B has a monthly premium.

Medicare also covers prescription drugs (Part D) and voluntary supplemental coverage (Part C and Part D). For more information, visit ssa.gov/locator.
