

**RESOLUTION OF THE [REDACTED] REAUTHORIZING
CERTAIN AGENCY STAFF TO WORK WITH HUD TO PROVIDE HOUSING COUNSELING
SERVICES TO THE RESIDENTS OF [REDACTED]**

WHEREAS, the [REDACTED] (the "Agency") exists and operates pursuant to the [REDACTED] for the purposes "of alleviating hardship which results from insufficient production of private homes and of rental housing for persons and families of low and moderate income, including the elderly . . . the deleterious effect of inadequate housing upon the general welfare of the [REDACTED] . . . by broadening the market for private homes and for housing for persons and families of low and moderate-income, through the provision of specialized financing secured by mortgages to corporations, individuals, joint ventures, partnerships, limited partnerships, trusts, cooperatives and condominiums"; and

WHEREAS, the Agency has promoted and supported housing counseling services to the residents of the [REDACTED]; and

WHEREAS, the Agency continues to promote and support housing counseling services to the residents of the [REDACTED]; and

WHEREAS, the Agency seeks to continue to work with and to promote HUD-certified housing counseling services.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the members of the [REDACTED] on this [REDACTED], as follows:

Section 1. The Agency reauthorizes and reiterates Agency staff's authority to provide housing counseling services to the residents of the [REDACTED] in accordance with 24 C.F.R. § 214.103(a).

Section 2. Staff are authorized to provide such housing counseling services to the residents of the [REDACTED] through HUD-certified counseling staff following all applicable HUD counseling guidelines, policies, and procedures.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
