Respondent Login Screen

Each respondent must have a userid and password to use the Send2NCEI tool.



Send2NCEI: Sign in

Send2NCEI (S2N) is an archiving tool that allows you to easily submit your data files and related documentation to the National Centers for Environmental Information (NCEI) for long term preservation, stewardship, and access. S2N will help you meet your requirements for data documentation, sharing, and

archiving. The system enables more efficient processing and archiving of your datasets. If this is your first time using S2N, set up an account and within minutes you will be well on your way to submitting your first data package!


S2N is meant to be used for the submission of standalone data packages less than 20GB in total size. Before contributing data, first time submitters should email ncei.archive@noaa.gov to consult with an archive specialist. Our staff can help you choose the correct submission method and provide a detailed explanation of the data submission process.




