If your child is between 18 and 71 months of age, we invite you and your child to participate in a research study at the University of Michigan Transportation Research Institute. You'll receive \$40 for two hours of participation.

If your child is between 3 months and 11 years old, we invite you and your child to participate in a research study at the University of Michigan Transportation Research Institute. You'll receive \$50 for two hours of participation.

For all children (<1 to 11 years): You will stay with your child at all times.

For children 3-24 months: Your child will play with items that look like toys, squeezing with their fingers and pushing and pulling with their hands and feet, so that we can measure their strength
