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I do not understand how the cancellation of F2S programming and the LFS aligns with the administration's intent of Making America Healthy Again. It is my understanding that we are trying to get Americans to eat healthier foods and improving health holistically through nutrition and exercise. The cuts to these programs only create larger barriers to school-aged children to eating healthy, local, nutritious food. Our school was going to expand our community and hydroponic vegetable gardens. We already grow a lot of our own salad greens and wanted to grow more vegetables for our cafeteria kitchen to increase scratch cooking. Now we won't and will need to purchase more prepared foods. This does not align with Making America Health Again. We want student to take ownership of the food by teaching where food comes from, how it is grown, how it harvested, how it's processed, and how it's prepared. Cuts to F2S and LFS prevent this type of ownership of food.
