What are the Research Activities at Nonprofit Organizations module of the Annual Business Survey (ABS)?

The Research Activities at Nonprofit Organizations module of the Annual Business Survey was introduced in 2021. The module measures research and experimental development (R&D) performance and funding at U.S. tax-exempt nonprofit organizations. Included are all nonfarm businesses filing Internal Revenue Service (IRS) tax forms as nonprofit organizations with an annual payroll of \$500,000 or more.

How do I know this is a legitimate government survey?
