

OIL & GAS FATIGUE STUDY

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The National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH) is the federal institute that conducts research and makes recommendations for preventing work-related injuries, illnesses, and deaths. **NIOSH is working with industry partners to study fatigue among onshore oil and gas workers.**

ABOUT THE STUDY

The fatigue study will take place at your workplace during business hours and consists of two sections:

- Measuring fatigue with surveys, wristwatch sensors, and daily check-ins.
- A one-hour focus group or interview.



PARTICIPATION

Most oil and gas workers and supervisors with at least 3 months of experience are eligible to participate. Participation and responses are strictly confidential. Final study results will not identify individual workers. Participants will receive a gift card as a token of appreciation.
