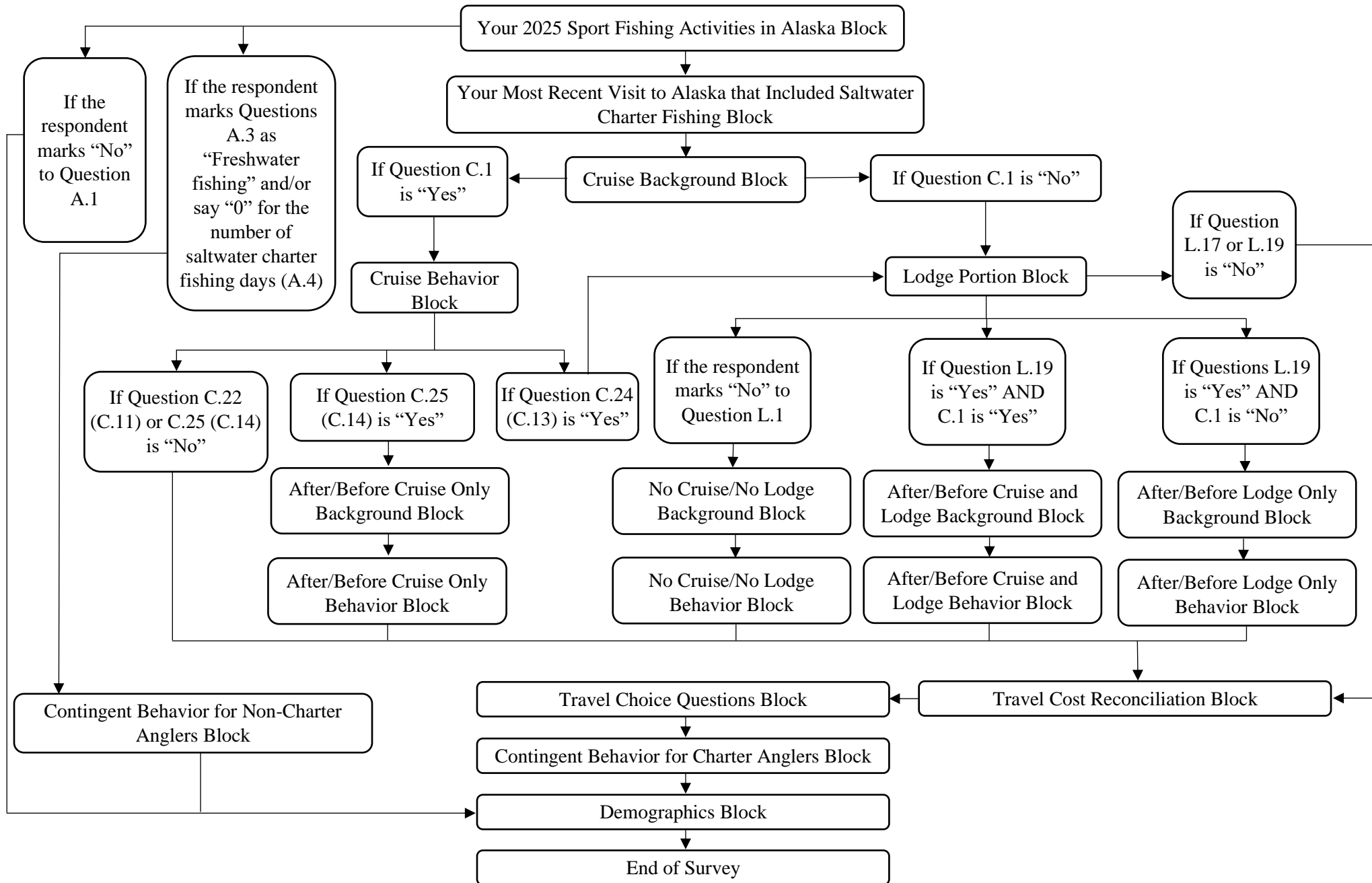







Survey Flow Diagram

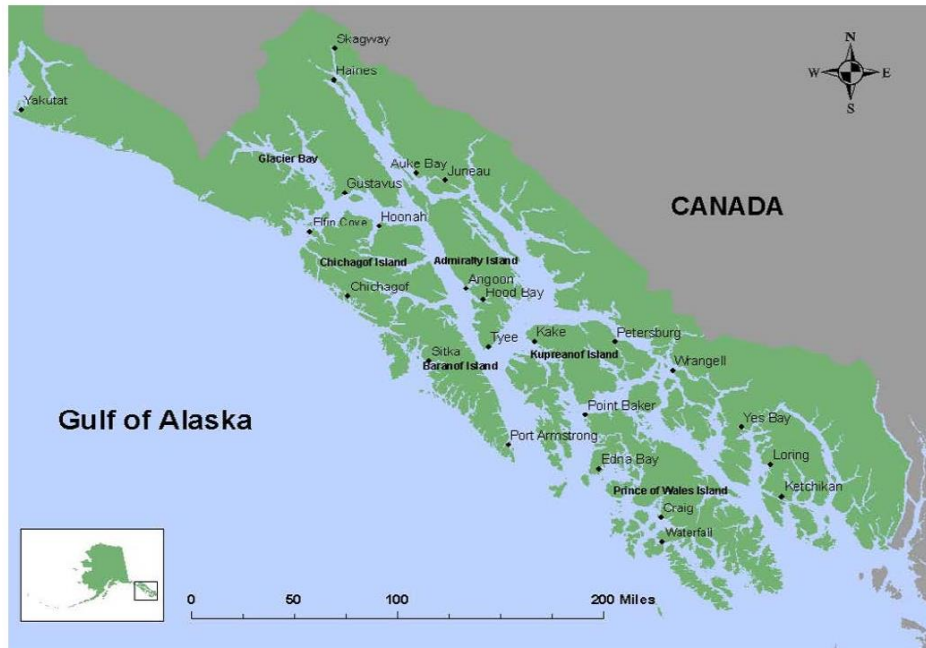

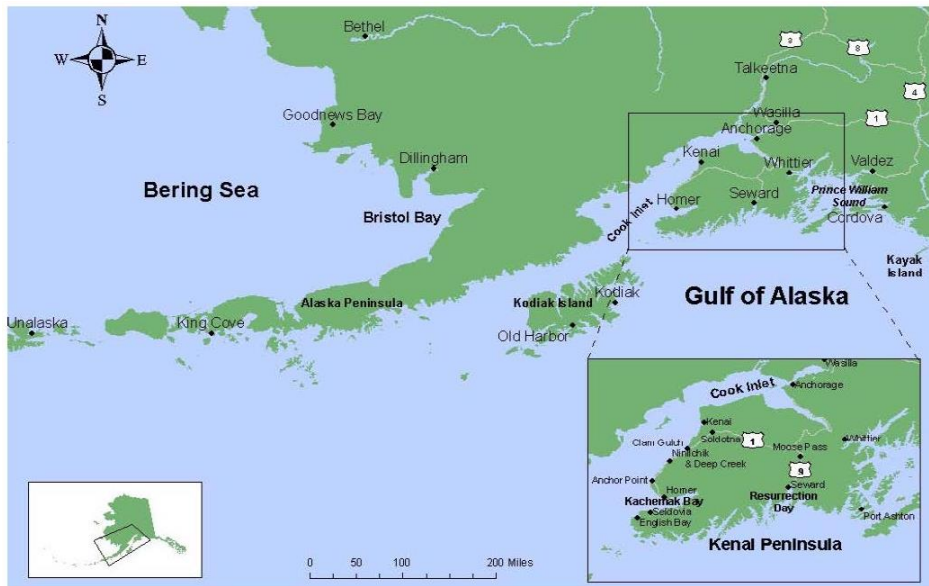


Map A: Southeast Alaska

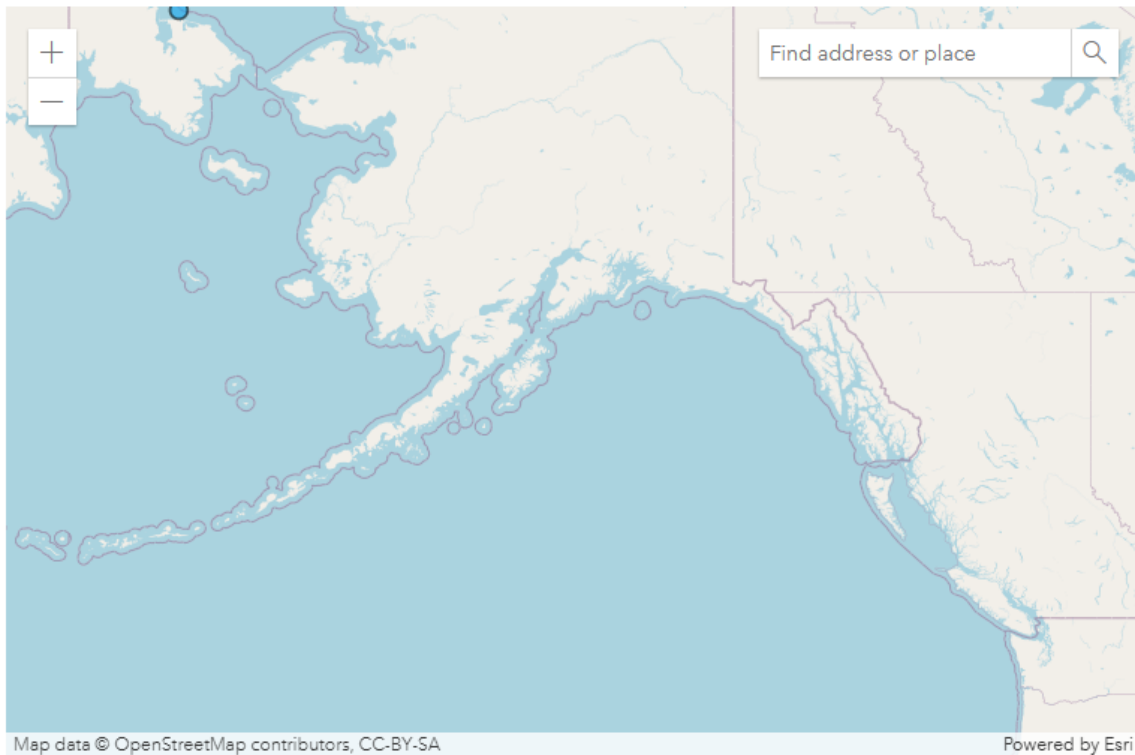

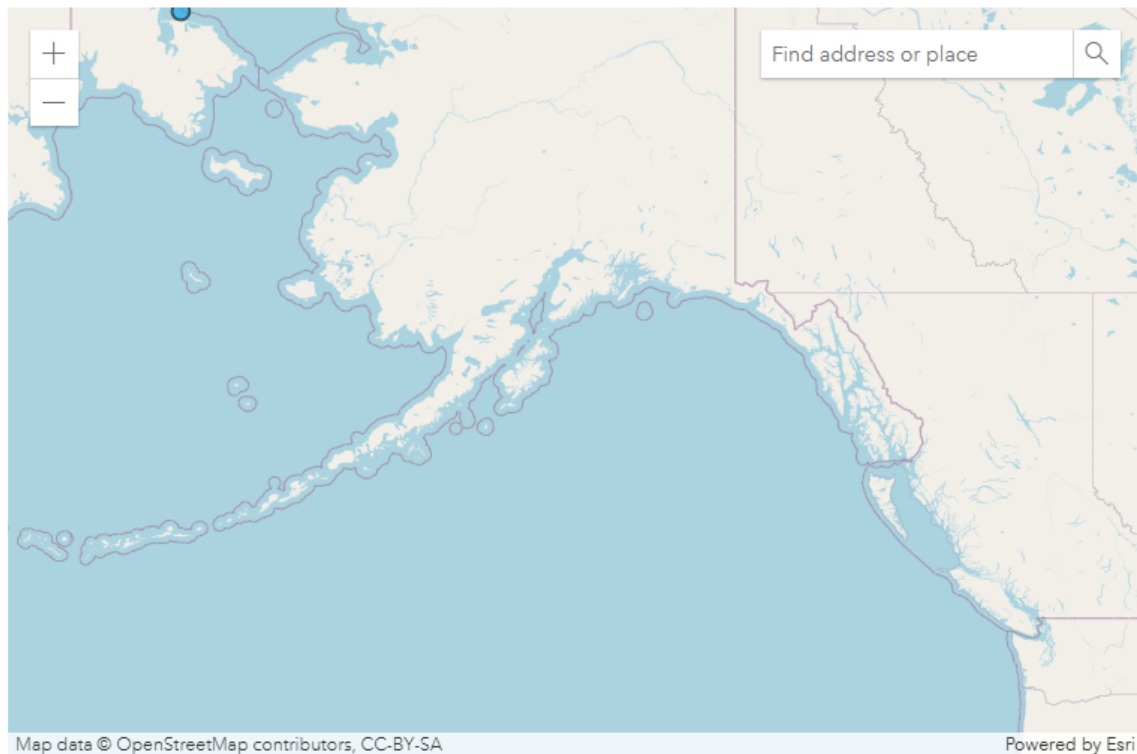

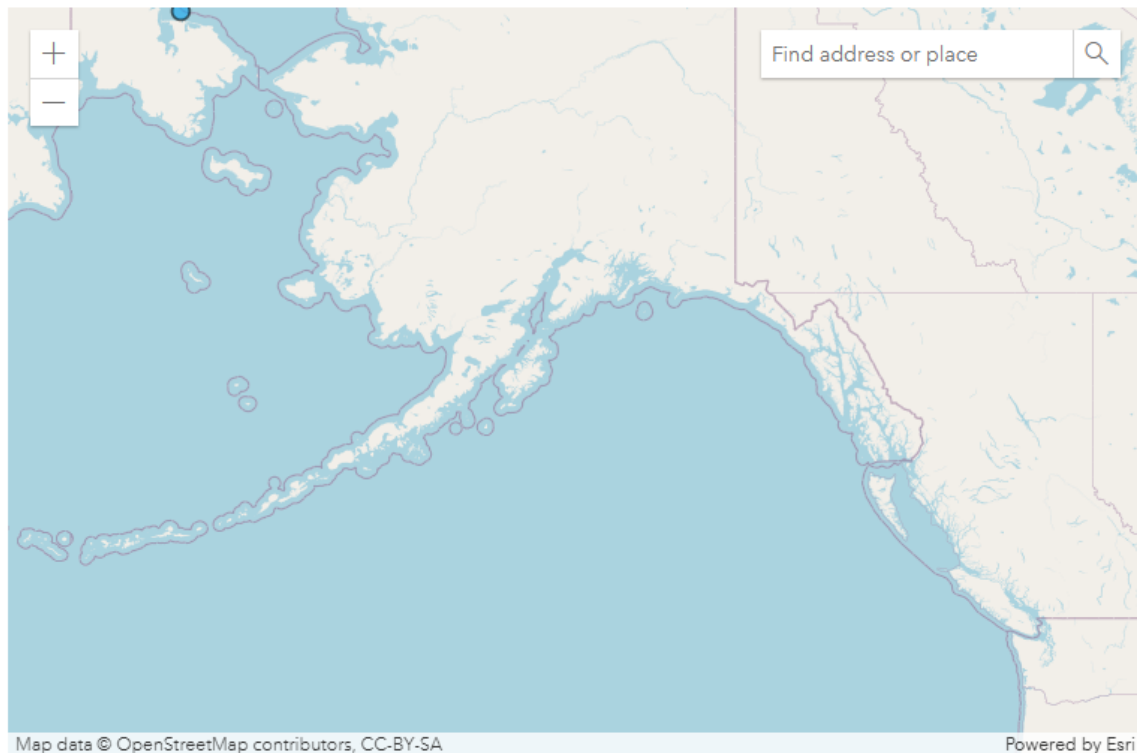

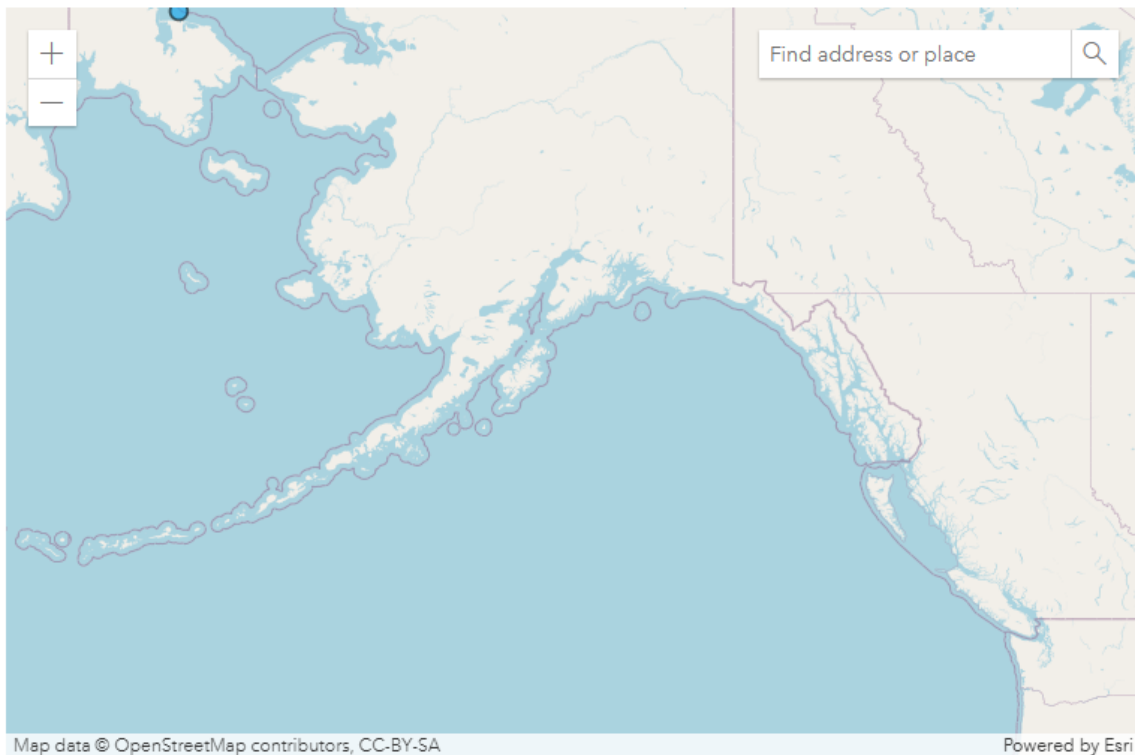
