The SF 1437, SF 1439 and SF 1440 are forms that should no longer be required for Termination Settlement Proposals (TSP). The structure of these forms are difficult to navigate, are not conducive to most contracts (especially cost reimbursable professional service contracts), and are largely repetitive of what is already included in the TSP. Of biggest note is that there are no observable benefits to the USG of continuing to require any of the SF 1437, SF 1439 or SF 1440 forms and instead only create additional work for both contractors and USG employees. Removing these forms from the TSP process would have no negative impacts to the USG and would instead further streamline the TSP process and expedite the development and the review of most TSPs.
