The purpose of this survey is to learn more about the experience of participants of the Workforce Acceleration Initiative (WAI) Technical Assistance Program. The WAI Technical Assistance Program offers Public Health Agencies (PHA) and WAI Placements support to increase their capacity to accomplish their systems improvement priorities and goals.

The WAI is implemented by the CDC Foundation through the Association of Public Health Laboratories (APHL), to recruit, hire, and place 127 technology and data experts directly in 49 diverse public health agencies to accelerate their priority information system improvements, strengthen the public health workforce at all levels, and advance progress towards Public Health Data Strategy (PHDS) goals.
