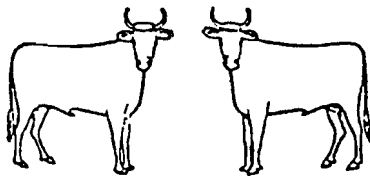

Unless authorized by the officers issuing and approving this permit in writing, only livestock bearing the brands and marks herein shown shall be grazed under authority of this assigned permit:

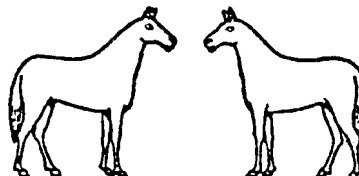
