Justification for No Material/Non-Substantive Change

The U.S. Merit Systems Protection Board (MSPB) requests a no material/non-substantive change to the e-Appeal collection instruments in all the collection mediums: paper, Portable Document Format (PDF), and through MSPB's electronic filing system, e-Appeal. There are minor language changes being proposed for the following.

- Clarification in Appendix B of the Initial Appeal Form to remove the New York Field Office and update the Geographic Area for the Northeastern Regional Office.
- Clarification in the technical support request form to provide users with additional information to assist in submitting a comprehensive request for support.
- Clarification in the e-Appeal Online Registration process to provide registrants with additional information regarding the final steps in the registration process.
- Clarification in the Security Policy Warning to correct confusing language.
