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## LEA form changes

For the new elements that reference students enrolled in the LEA and served in non-LEA facilities, I feel that LEAs need very specific definitions about what enrolled in the LEA means in relation to this question.

Are you looking at students who live in the LEA and are enrolled in private schools?

Special education students who live in the LEA and are the responsibility of the LEA, but are placed elsewhere in a special education program?

What about preschool students who get special education services in the LEA, but attend daycare or private preschool?

## School form changes

I feel that the Informal Removal Definition needs to be defined for LEAs in a more detailed manner.

Is this data element meant to catalog the times a student is sent to the principal's office, guidance office, nurses office?

Is the data element looking for time spent outside of the classroom for Restorative Practices?

Is the data element changing the definition of In School Suspension and using Informal Removal as the words instead?

What is the severity of discipline or severity of removal that the data element is looking for?

I am very concerned about the part of the definition that reads "incidents that may or may not be documented" If the incident is not documented, how could an LEA report on it?

## Overall changes

I am 100% in favor of complying with the revised SPD 15 standards in the Federal Register (89 FR 22182). Our students and families have been requesting this data reporting change for decades, and we can't edit our student information system until the state or federal government can use the new guidelines.
