





Mission Description

The Interstellar Mapping and Acceleration Probe (IMAP) will observe and map the Sun's heliosphere – the volume of space filled with particles streaming out from the Sun, known as the solar wind – and study how it interacts with the local galactic neighborhood beyond. The boundary zone at the edge of the heliosphere offers protection from the harsher radiation of interstellar space; it may have played a role in creating a habitable solar system and is critical in NASA's plans for safe human exploration of the Moon and Mars.

Space Weather Follow On at L1 (SWFO-L1) is a National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) mission with the goal of providing continuous measurements of the space environment and observations of the Sun's outer atmosphere and contributing to accurate forecasts of space weather disturbances. The SWFO-L1 project will use a suite of instruments to make real time measurements of the solar wind, thermal plasma, and the magnetic field. Mission Description
The Interstellar Mapping and Acceleration Probe (IMAP) will observe and map the Sun's heliosphere – the volume of space filled with particles streaming out from the Sun, known as the solar wind – and study how it interacts with the local galactic neighborhood beyond. The boundary zone at the edge of the heliosphere offers protection from the harsher radiation of interstellar space; it may have played a role in creating a habitable solar system and is critical in NASA's plans for safe human exploration of the Moon and Mars.

Space Weather Follow On at L1 (SWFO-L1) is a National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) mission with the goal of providing continuous measurements of the space environment and observations of the Sun's outer atmosphere and contributing to accurate forecasts of space weather disturbances. The SWFO-L1 project will use a suite of instruments to make real time measurements of the solar wind, thermal plasma, and the magnetic field. The L1 orbit allows for continuous unobstructed observation of the corona without interference from the Earth.

The Carruthers Geocorona Observatory will survey the exosphere, the outermost layer of Earth's atmosphere, seeking answers like its shape, size, and density and what causes them to change over time.
